Prescott Registration

Prescott neighborhood families:

If you have a child who lives in Prescott's attendance area, your child is automatically accepted at Prescott School. Please submit enrollment papers in March of the preceding year of entrance in order to secure your child's spot.

For families living outside Prescott's neighborhood:

Prescott receives hundreds of applications from students who reside outside the school's attendance area. Please complete an application and submit it to the school by the lottery's annual deadline.
